Submissions: Last date for turning in essay, story or poem submissions is October 15th, 2010. The written work must be turned in to any teacher in your school or to the District Office. All submissions must have ALL of the following information clearly visible on the back of your work:

4. The story must be 1500 words or less, on the provided theme.
5. The poem must be 30 lines or less, with a maximum of 65 characters per line, on the provided theme.
6. Only one entry per student, per category, per contest.
7. Each page should include the title of your work.

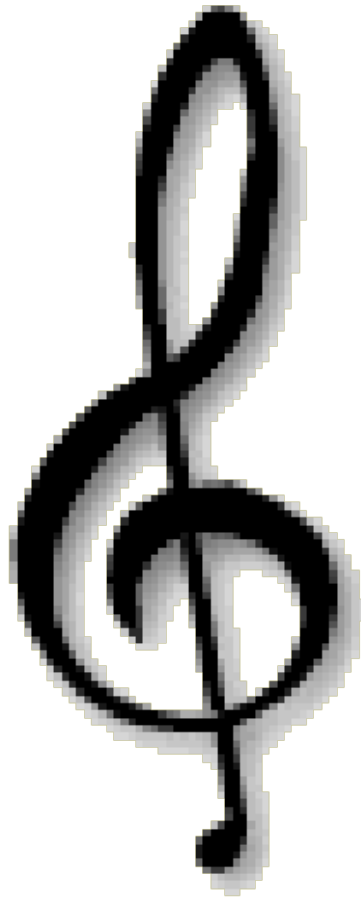

6. 2-D or 3-D entries will not be accepted. Any photo or computerized graphics may be used in your artwork or as your entire artwork. Your art piece must stand alone, without any fixatives.
7. Any winning entries will be reproduced into a stamp; this is also one of your judging criteria.
